EXPERIENCE SUMMARY

Backend-focused software developer at Jitume, a government agency working with the Technopolis Development Authority to equip young Kenyans with digital skills and access to online work. I earned the role by placing among the five national winners of the 2026 Jitume Digital Media Factory hackathon. My work centres on building and maintaining RESTful APIs in Python, designing the database layer behind them, integrating third-party services, and implementing authentication and role-based access control. I am a 2026 graduate of Moringa School's Software Engineering programme, and I also hold a BTech in Journalism and Mass Communication, a background that makes me comfortable writing clear documentation and explaining technical decisions to people who are not engineers.

KEY SKILLS

- **Backend development:** Design, build and maintain RESTful APIs in Python using FastAPI and Flask.
- **Third-party integrations:** Connect internal services to external APIs, handling data mapping, error states and retries; a core part of my current role.
- **Database design and querying:** Model relational schemas and write the SQL behind the endpoints I build, working in PostgreSQL and SQLite.
- **Authentication and access control:** Implement authentication flows and role-based permissions so the right users reach the right data.
- **Technical communication:** Journalism-trained writer; produce API documentation and handover notes that non-technical stakeholders can act on.
